Matter has been taken up through video conferencing via Webex facility in the light of the Pandemic Covid-19 situation and as per instructions.

The present petition has been filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C seeking the benefit of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.114 dated 6.4.2021 under sections 148, 149, 323, 324, 307, 341, 354-A, 506 I.P.C, registered at Police Station, Rania, District Sirsa.

Learned counsel for the petitioner vehemently contends that the petitioner was falsely implicated in the present FIR and no offence, as alleged, is made out against him. It has been further contended that even the name mentioned in the FIR is not clear and therefore the petitioner is not specifically named in the FIR. It is contended that no specific allegation of causing any injury by the petitioner is made out against the petitioner. Counsel further contends that petitioner is behind bars since 21.4.2021.

On the other hand, learned State counsel has opposed the grant of bail to the petitioner. It has been contended that there is no specific

injury attributed to the petitioner, however, challan is presented qua all the three accused and all are behind bars. It has been further contended that further proceedings are yet to take place.

In the totality of circumstances and without making any observations on merits, present petition is allowed. Petitioner be enlarged on bail subject to satisfaction of Trial Court/Duty Magistrate, concerned. Nothing stated herein shall be treated as an expression on the merits of the case.
