The petitioners pray for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No. 312 dated 14.12.2020, registered under Sections 307, 336, 323, 325 (added later on), 341, 427, 506, 148, 149, 120-B of the IPC and Sections 25, 27 of the Arms Act, 1959 at Police Station City Sangrur, District Sangrur.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that as per allegations in the FIR, registered at the instance of Babandeep Singh, it is stated that on 14.12.2020, there was a protest of the farmers and during that process, there was a scuffle, in which the complainant and others have suffered injuries.

For the sake of brevity, the details of the FIR are not given as it is the case of the petitioners that they had no role and were nominated later on during investigation and also in view of the fact that the parties have already compromised their dispute, vide compromise dated 27.04.2021 and on the basis of the same, a petition, bearing **CRM-M-21566-2021** titled as

Vijay Kumar @ Vijay Lankesh and ors. vs. State of Punjab and ors., has already been filed before this Court, in which on 02.07.2021, a direction has been issued to trial Court to record the statement of the parties with regard to compromise.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Joginder Pal Ratra, DAG, Punjab and Mr. Ramandeep Singh, Advocate, who are also appearing through video conferencing, accept notice on behalf of the respondent-State and complainant, respectively.

Learned counsel for the complainant acknowledges the fact that there is compromise between the parties.

In view of the above, the present petition is allowed and the petitioners are granted concession of anticipatory bail, subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

However, it will be open for the Investigating Officer to call upon the petitioners to join investigation, if so required, by issuing them a written notice in this regard.
