This is a petition filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking issuance of a writ of mandamus directing the respondents to release the salary to the petitioner since his appointment vide order dated 22.03.2019 has not been paid, with certain other prayers made in the petition.

Learned counsel for respondent Nos.1 to 3 has submitted that the salary of the petitioner has been released as per his due entitlements. Hence, the present writ petition has been rendered infructuous.

There is no representation on behalf of the petitioner. It appears that the petitioner is satisfied with the release of the salary, which was the only demand raised in the present petition.

In view of the above, the present writ petition is dismissed as having been rendered infructuous.
