The health status report by way of affidavit of Baljit Singh, PPS,
Superintendent Central Jail, Kapurthala has been placed on record wherein it has
been mentioned as following:-

“It is submitted that Nirankar Singh S/o
Karam Singh was known Case of psychiatric
illness before coming to jail, Kapurthala. He
was referred to G.M.C & Hospital, Sector
32, Chandigarh on dated 16.10.2020, as per
compliance of the order of Hon'ble High
Court. He was checked up by the Doctors of
G.M.C & Hospital, Sector 32, Chandigarh.
He was advised admission and was
prescribed treatment. The patient is taking
medication as advised by the Doctors of
G.M.C & Hospital, Sector 32, Chandigarh
under strict supervision.

On 25.11.2020, he was referred to G.M.C & Hospital, Sector 32, Chandigarh in department of Psychiatric and medicine was prescribed by the doctor and referred to cardiology department (for complains of pain left arm and heaviness in left arm (02) months ECG was advised which was within normal limits.

On 21.12.2020, he was referred to Civil Hospital, Kapurthala in emergency department for complains of acute depression, hypertension with sleep apnea from where he was referred to GMC & Hospital Amritsar for treatment on the same day and he was admitted on 21.12.2020 and discharged on 28.12.2020 from GMC & Hospital Amritsar. He was under treatment in Jail Hospital, Kapurthala as advised by the doctors of GMD & Hospital, Amritsar.

On 04.01.2021, he was again referred to Civil Hospital, Kapurthala in emergency department with complaint of Sever headache and suicidal tendencies and spell of crying. He was advised by Civil Hospital, Kapurthala to continue medicine as prescribed by GMC & Hospital, Amritsar and also advised for referral to multispecialty health Institution.

On 14.01.2021, he was referred to G.M.C. & Hospital, Sector 32, Chandigarh as advised by Civil Hospital, Kapurthala. Now he is under treatment in Jail Hospital, Kapurthala as medicine prescribed by G.M.C. & Hospital, Sector 32, Chandigarh”.

Section 302 IPC for having committed murder of his wife by giving six gun shots injuries on her face and chest. The order dated 16.07.2020 passed by the learned Court of Sessions also indicates that the Board of Doctors of Department of Psychiatric G.M.C & Hospital, Sector 32, Chandigarh after thorough examination had declared him of sound mind and capable of taking decisions. The interim bail has been sought on the health grounds.

In the instant case, there are serious allegations against the petitioner. Furthermore, he is being provided appropriate medical treatment as per the report submitted by way of affidavit of Baljit Singh, PPS, Superintendent Central Jail, Kapurthala. The petitioner is being provided appropriate medical treatment as advised by G.M.C & Hospital, Sector 32, Chandigarh and is being also referred to the hospital as and when required.

Keeping in view aforesaid circumstances, no ground is made out to extend the concession of interim bail to the petitioner.

In view of the above, the present petition is dismissed.
