This case has been taken up through Video Conferencing via Webex facility in the light of Pandemic Covid-19 situation and as per instructions.

In terms of memo dated 24.7.1987 at Annexure P-1 one Sh.Badri Parshad s/o Ram Pal was offered a bare site No. 255 measuring 400 Sq. Yards in Khuda Lahora, U.T. Chandigarh on hire-purchase basis. Apparently aforesaid Badri Parshad gave a general power of attorney in favour of Manoj Kumar s/o Mewa Lal in respect of the property in question in the year 2006.

Instant petition has been filed by Badri Parshad through GPA holder Manoj Kumar raising a grievance that the premises in question has been sealed behind his back and without issuing any show-cause notice etc. Directions have been sought to the respondents to desal the premises.

On the previous date of hearing Mr. Piyush Khanna, Advocate had entered appearance on behalf of respondent-U.T. Chandigarh and he had

been requested to complete instructions in the matter.

During the course of hearing Mr. Khanna informs us that the representations have already been submitted by Badri Parshad as also GPA holder for desealing of the premises and the same are still pending consideration.

Undertaking is furnished that a final decision in such regard would be taken in accordance with law and would be conveyed to the petitioner within a period of six weeks from today.

Statement is accepted.

No further directions are required to be passed.

Petition is disposed of.

It is clarified that we have not opined on the merits of the case.
