On 29.07.2021, this Court had made a direction upon the trial Court concerned to make a report with respect to the genuineness of the compromise arrived at inter se the accused and the complainant.

Pursuant to the aforemade order, the learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Kapurthala has transmitted to this court, the apposite report detailing therein that, the compromise (supra) arrived at *interse* the complainant and the petitioner, is voluntary and genuine besides it is free from any vice of coercion or undue influence exercised by the accused, upon, the complainant.

Believing the statements made at the bar, by the learned Assistant Advocate General, that the investigation into offences constituted in FIR No.87 dated 12.04.2021 detailing therein offences constituted under Section 379, 341, 506 of IPC registered at Police Station City Kapurthala, District Kapurthala, is still at the pre-challan stage. Therefore, bearing in mind the aforemade transmitted report to this court, by the learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, this

court deems it fit to allow the petition, and, to quash the FIR No.87 dated 12.04.2021, detailing therein offences constituted under Section 379, 341, 506 of IPC, registered at Police Station City Kapurthala, District Kapurthala.
