The matter has been taken up through video-conferencing on account of outbreak of pandemic COVID-19.

The petitioners have come up in this civil writ petition under articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking a prayer by way of writ of *mandamus* by directing the respondents to release the revised pension and other retiral benefits on the basis of last pay drawn by them at the time of their retirement while performing the duties of higher posts in officiating capacity with all consequential benefits alongwith interest @ 12% per annum, for which, legal notice dated 01.03.2021 (Annexure P-9)

has also been served upon the respondents.

In the light of oral submissions of the petitioners' side the directions are issued to respondents to duly consider the the legal notice dated 01.03.2021 (Annexure P-9) as representation of the petitioners and decide the same in accordance with law by passing a speaking order, preferably, within a period of one month from the date of passing of this order.
