As per the office report, notice issued to the respondent has been received back served, however, he remains unrepresented.

This is an application filed by the respondent's wife praying for transfer of the proceedings of case No.DMC/1111/2020, titled as “Radhe Shyam Vs. Manju Verma”, presently pending in the Family Court, Hisar to the Court of competent jurisdiction at Sirsa, where other matters arising out from the marital discord are pending.

The petitioner alleges that the respondent is defending proceedings in FIR No.9, dated 08.01.2021, under Section 323, 498-A and 506 IPC registered at Police Station Civil Lines, Sirsa and proceedings under Section 125 Cr.P.C. She is stated to be taking care of two children while residing at Sirsa.

In view thereof, the application is allowed.

The petition under Section 9 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955, bearing case No.No.DMC/1111/2020, titled as “Radhe Shyam Vs. Manju Verma”, pending in the Court of Principal Judge, Family Court, Hisar, is

ordered to be transferred to the Court of competent jurisdiction at Sirsa.

The transferor Court is requested to remit the case file to the transferee Court forthwith.

The parties through their counsel are directed to appear before the transferee Court on 08.10.2021.

All the pending miscellaneous applications, if any, are also disposed of.
