By this petition, the petitioner seeks the concession of 'pre-arrest bail' upon FIR No. 975, having been registered at Police Station Chandni Bagh, District Panipat, on 10.10.2019, alleging therein the commission of an offence punishable under the provisions of Section 379-A of the IPC.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Parminder Singh, submits that the petitioner has joined investigation pursuant to the order dated 15.07.2021 and presently his custodial interrogation is not required.

In view of above, the petition has actually been rendered infructuous and is disposed of as such.

However, if the petitioners' custodial interrogation is required at any stage hereinafter, in the context of the FIR in question, she would be given 7 days notice before arrest, duly shown to be served upon her.

Naturally, if the complainant is aggrieved in any manner, of lack of proper investigation, she would be always at liberty to avail of her remedy as per law.
