Matter has been taken up through video conferencing via Webex facility in the light of the Pandemic Covid-19 situation and as per instructions.

Petitioner has preferred the instant petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C., for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No. 31 dated 13.03.2021, under Sections 304-B, 306, 34 of IPC, registered at Police Station D-Division, Distt. Amritsar.

By virtue of the order dated 03.08.2021, while granting interim protection, the petitioner was directed to join investigation.
