Through this petition, the petitioner seeks anticipatory bail in case bearing FIR No.42 dated 30.03.2021, registered at Police Station Amargarh, District Sangrur, under Sections 22 and 29 NDPS Act.

Vide order dated 19.07.2021 passed by this Court, the petitioner had been granted *ad interim* pre-arrest bail and directed to join investigation.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that pursuant to the order dated 19.07.2021 passed by this Court, the petitioner has joined investigation.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Balbir Singh, submits that the petitioner has joined investigation and is now not required for any further investigation.

Since the petitioner has joined investigation, filing of the status report by the State, is dispensed with.

In view of the above, without commenting on the merits of

the case, the present petition is allowed and the order dated 19.07.2021 granting interim bail to the petitioner, is made absolute, subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438 (2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
