Case taken up through video conferencing.

The petitioners are seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.9 dated 08.01.2019, under Sections 406, 420, 467, 468, 471, 120-B IPC, registered at Police Station Dhand, District Kaithal.

Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that the allegations are that the accused in connivance with the officials of the tehsil created forged and fake documents and had obtained loan from the bank illegally. He, however, contends that the loan amount has been returned by the petitioners and nothing is to be recovered from them. A copy of the one time settlement dated 30.07.2021 is annexed as Annexure P-6.

This Court, by the order dated 06.08.2021, had directed the petitioners to appear before the Investigating Officer and join the investigation and in the event of their arrest, they were ordered to be released on ad-interim bail to the satisfaction of the Investigating/Arresting Officer, subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from SI Shamsheer Singh, states that the petitioners have joined investigation.

In view of the above and the petitioners having joined investigation, the order dated 06.08.2021 granting interim bail to the petitioners is made absolute.

However, the petitioners shall abide by the conditions stipulated under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. They shall also join investigation as and when called upon to do so.

The petition stands disposed of.
