The matter has been taken up through video-conferencing on account of outbreak of pandemic COVID-19.

The petitioner has come up in this civil writ petition under articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking a prayer by way of writ of *mandamus* by directing the respondents to count the previous respective work charge service of the petitioners rendered by them with respondent No. 4 as qualifying service for the purpose of pensionary benefits, for which, legal notice dated 27.02.2020 (Annexure P-7) has also been served upon the respondents.

In the light of oral submissions of the petitioner side the directions are issued to respondents to duly consider the the legal notice dated 27.02.2020 (Annexure P-7) as representation of the petitioner and decide the same in accordance with law by passing a speaking order, preferably, within a period of one month from the date of passing of this order.
