Petitioner has filed this petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail, pending trial in case FIR No.112 dated 18.05.2018, under Section 22 N.D.P.S.Act, 1985, registered at Police Station, Kotwali, District Bathinda.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Sukhwinder Singh, has stated that out of total eleven prosecution witnesses, ten stand examined. According to him, only one prosecution witness, namely, ASI Gurmukh Singh, remains to be examined and the case is coming up on 23.12.2021 before the trial court.

Considering the advanced stage of the trial, no case is made out for grant of regular bail to the petitioner.
