The hearing of the case was held through video conferencing on account of restricted functioning of the Courts.

This is an application filed by the wife of the respondent and her son with a prayer to transfer the proceedings in case bearing No.HMA/65/2020, titled as “Balwinder Singh Vs. Nisha”, filed under Section 9 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955, presently pending in the Court of Additional District Judge, Rupnagar to the Court of competent jurisdiction at Jalandhar.

Learned counsel representing the respondent does not dispute that he is defending proceedings in an application filed under Section 125 Cr.P.C. which is pending before the Family Court, Jalandhar. The petitioner along with her child is residing with her parents at Jalandhar.

A complaint filed before the Commissioner of Police, Jalandhar is also stated to be pending at Jalandhar.

In view thereof, the application is allowed.

The petition under Section 9 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955, bearing case No.HMA/65/2020, titled as “Balwinder Singh Vs. Nisha”, presently pending before the Court of Additional District Judge, Rupnagar, is ordered to be transferred to the Court of competent jurisdiction at Jalandhar.

The transferor Court is requested to remit the case file to the transferee Court forthwith.

The parties through their counsel are directed to appear before the transferee Court on 21.10.2021.

All the pending miscellaneous applications, if any, are also disposed of.
