The hearing of the case was held through video
conferencing on account of restricted functioning of the Courts.

Allowed as prayed for. The memorandum of the petitioner
society is taken on record.

Main case

The petitioner before this Court is a registered Citizen
committee of house owners of Sector 25, Panchkula. Through the
present writ petition, the petitioner claims the following substantive
reliefs:-

“i) To issue a writ in the nature of
mandamus be issued directing the respondents to take
effective measures as per representation submitted to
respondents (Annexure P-7) and take immediate steps
to check the rising of stray cattle nuisance in the area

of Panchkula Extension (Haryana) and its neighbourhood area in the District Panchkula, Haryana.

ii) Further direct to respondent no.2 to take into custody the abandoned, stray, confiscate or seized cow from the concerned local bodies, other competent authorities and to maintain them.

iii) Further, directing the respondents to take proper and earmark suitable areas for relocate stray cattle from sector 25, Panchkula and its neighbourhood area in district Panchkula, Haryana to the Gaushala in the respondents area.

iv) Further, directing the respondents to perform its public/statutory duties and to ensure the compliance of the laws to keep area free of rubbish and other articles, so, the stray cattle are not attracted to the location which remains clean at all times.”

The petitioner is also stated to have made a representation in this regard to the Commissioner, Municipal Corporation, Panchkula on 14.02.2021. However, it is the case of the petitioner that no action thereon has been taken.

Heard learned counsel for the petitioner at some length and with his able assistance, perused the paper book.

Keeping in view the controversy involved, it is considered

appropriate to request the Additional Chief Secretary, Department of Local Bodies, Haryana, to look into the matter expeditiously and take the remedial measures, if any required. Let the petitioner serve a copy of the writ petition on the Additional Chief Secretary, Department of Local Bodies, Haryana, for an appropriate action.

With these observations, the writ petition is disposed of.

All the pending miscellaneous applications, if any, are also disposed of.
