The present petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, seeking a writ in the nature of *habeas corpus* for releasing the detenue namely Jaswinder Kaur (aged 16 years) and Raji Bala (aged 15 years).

Status report has been filed in which it is stated that both the aforesaid girls now have been recovered and their statements have also been recorded before the learned trial Magistrate and in fact, they have named two boys against whom FIR has also been registered under Section 376 IPC and both the girls have now been restored to the petitioner who is the mother of the girls and therefore, the present petition has become infructuous.

Mr.Jasminder Singh, Advocate, has caused appearance on behalf of respondent Nos.5 to 7.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has stated that since the girls have now been recovered and restored to the petitioner, the present petition has become infructuous and be disposed of accordingly.
