Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the present is a case, where the brother of the petitioner has died and no action is being taken to investigate the unnatural death of the brother of the petitioner. The prayer of the petitioner is for conducting free and fair investigation in the death of the brother of the petitioner.

In reply, the respondent-State has mentioned that after the death, the statements of the wife of the deceased namely Jaskaran Kaur, as well as that of petitioner, were recorded, wherein, they submitted that they suspect no foul play in the death of the deceased.

As per the reply filed, in the statement given by the wife of the deceased, it has been mentioned that the deceased was an addict and she does not suspect any foul play and in the statement given by the petitioner

before the police, which has appended as Annexure R-2, he has submitted that his brother hanged himself.

Learned counsel for the petitioner is disputing these statements and states that signatures were taken from the petitioner as well as the wife of the deceased on a blank paper where these statements have been recorded.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that as the police has closed down the case, he be given liberty to approach the competent Court of law involving the relevant provisions of the Cr.P.C for the redressal of his grievance.

Ordered accordingly.
