By this petition, the petitioner seeks the concession of 'regular bail' under the provisions of Section 439 Cr.P.C., upon FIR No.117, dated 15.05.2021, having been registered at Police Station Sadar, Amritsar, alleging therein the commission of an offence punishable under the provisions of Section 379-B of the IPC.

The petitioner having been in custody for about 6 ½ months now with the trial not having commenced though with the report under Section 173 of the Cr.P.C. having been submitted, and there being no other criminal case registered against the petitioner, as per instructions of learned state counsel, without making any comment on the actual merits of the case, the petition is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be admitted to bail, upon him furnishing adequate bail and surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial court/CJM/Duty Magistrate concerned.
