Prayer in this petition is for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No.195 dated 04.04.2019 under Sections 406, 420 IPC, registered at Police Station City Hansi, District Hisar.

While granting interim bail to the petitioner, following order was passed by this Court on 14.05.2019: -

“...Counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the police registered an FIR on the basis of a secret information that one Mohit is giving the advertisement in the newspaper in the name of Shri Ram Finance and is cheating the innocent persons by asking them to deposit Rs.9400/- in the account. It is further submitted

that on a raid conducted by the police, the said Mohit was arrested and some ATM cards and documents were recovered from him. It is also submitted that thereafter, one another co-accused namely Jaivardhan was arrested and thereafter, without there being any evidence, the petitioner has been nominated in the present case and the petitioner is running a departmental store in Zirakhpur whereas the incident pertains to Hansi...”

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in compliance of the aforesaid order, the petitioner has joined the investigation and is no more required for further investigation. It is further submitted that a period of about 02 years and 04 months has passed and there is no complaint against the petitioner that he has misused the concession of interim anticipatory bail.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from SI Kishan and on the basis of affidavit of DSP, City Hansi, has not disputed the factual position and submits that the petitioner is no more required for further investigation and challan stands presented.

In view of the above, this petition is allowed and the interim bail granted to the petitioner vide order dated 14.05.2019 is made absolute subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
