The hearing of the case was held through video conferencing on account of restricted functioning of the Courts.

The petitioner-husband has filed this revision petition under Article 227 of the Constitution of India, assailing the correctness of the order passed by the learned Additional District Judge, Rupnagar, directing him to pay maintenance pendente lite at the rate of Rs.7,000/- per month. The respondent-wife filed an application with specific assertion that her husband (the petitioner herein) has Motor Workshop in the name and style of “Palli Motor Works” in Motor Market, Manimajra, where he repairs high end luxury cars by earning Rs.1,00,000/- per month.

Learned counsel for the petitioner admits that there is no specific denial to the aforesaid assertion made in the application. However, he contends that there is no shop in the name of “Palli Motor Works”. If that be so, let the petitioner file an application before the trial court in this regard. If such application is filed, the same shall be

decided expeditiously.

With these observations, the revision petition is disposed of.

All the pending miscellaneous applications, if any, also stand disposed of.
