The matter has been taken up through video-conferencing on account of outbreak of pandemic COVID-19.

The petitioner has come up in this civil writ petition under articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking a prayer by way of writ of *mandamus* directing the respondents to decide the representations dated 03.10.2018 and 31.10.2018 (Annexure P-5 and Anneuxre P-6), respectively.

Counsel for the petitioner has also submitted that for redressal of the grievance of the petitioner legal notice (Annexure P-8) has also been served upon the respondent authorities.

Heard.

Upon hearing learned counsel for the petitioner side, the directions are issued to the respondent authorities to duly consider the representations dated 03.10.2018 and 31.10.2018 (Annexure P-5 and Anneuxre P-6, respectively) as well as legal notice (Annexure P-8) as representation of the petitioner and decide the same in accordance with law by passing a speaking order, preferably, within a period of one month from the date of passing of this order.

If the petitioner is held entitled for so claimed relief and there is no impediment for granting the same, the relief be released to him without any delay as per law.
