Prayer in the petition is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.215 dated 05.06.2021 under Sections 498-A, 406, 323 and 506 of the IPC, registered at Police Station City Kharar, District SAS Nagar, Mohali.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner who is the father-in-law of the complainant's daughter has been falsely implicated in the case in hand on account of the strained relations between the petitioner's son with his daughter-in-law i.e. complainant's daughter. He further submits that in compliance of the order dated 16.07.2021, the petitioner has joined the investigation and cooperated with the investigating agency.

Learned State counsel does not dispute the factum of the petitioner having joined investigation. She, on instructions from ASI Jaswant Singh, further submits that petitioner is not required for further

investigation much less the custodial interrogation.

In view of above, the petition is allowed and the order dated 02.05.2019 granting interim bail to petitioner, is made absolute. Petitioner shall abide by the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. in letter and spirit.
