[1] This petition was filed for issuance of directions to the official respondents not to harass the family members of the petitioners and to take action in FIR No. 117, dated 30th December, 2020, under Sections 420, 120-B IPC and Section 13 of Punjab Travel Professionals (Regulations) Act, 2014 registered at Police Station Purana Shalla, District Gurdaspur.

[2] Pursuant to the notice of motion, reply was filed.

[3] As per reply respondents No.6 and 7 (arrayed in the petition) have been found innocent, respondents No.8 and 9 are residing abroad and an application under Section 105-B Cr.P.C. has been filed before the Court concerned. Look Out Circulars (LOC) have also been issued against respondents No. 8 and 9.

[4] Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that respondents No.6 and 7 have been wrongly declared innocent.

[5] In view of reply dated 20th August, 2021, no further direction is called for.

[6] Disposed of as infructuous.

[7] However, petitioner would be at liberty to avail remedy for the rederessal of surviving grievances, if any. There is no doubt that in case the petitioner approaches the official respondents for getting the copy of inquiry report, the same would be supplied without any delay.
