The Court has been convened through video conferencing due to Covid-19 Pandemic.

Instant petition has been filed under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.116 dated 22.06.2014, registered for offences under Sections 452, 325, 323, 427, 506, 148 and 149 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860, at Police Station Sadar Khanna, District Ludhiana (Annexure P-1).

Having argued the petition for some time and realizing that the Court is not inclined to agree with the submissions made, counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner will surrender before the trial Court and file a petition for grant of regular bail.

In case the petitioner surrenders before the trial Court within a period of two weeks from today and files a petition seeking grant of regular bail, the trial Court shall make an endeavour and decide the same expeditiously. The petitioner shall deposit costs of Rs.5,000/- with the PGIMER, Poor Patient Welfare Fund, Sector 12, Chandigarh and furnish receipt of deposit before the trial Court. The deposit of costs shall be a pre-condition for entertaining the petition seeking regular bail.

Petition is disposed of.
