JASGURPREET SINGH PURI. J. (Oral)

At the outset, Mr. Panwar, learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Amit Kumar has submitted that in pursuance of the orders passed by this Court on 16.07.2021 the petitioner has already joined investigation and he has fully cooperated with the investigation process and he is not required for custodial interrogation. He has further submitted that the petitioner has not submitted his passport as directed by this Court, but he has submitted the copy of a DDR and has stated that his passport has been lost and, therefore, he could not submit the same. He has further submitted that be that as it may, in case the petitioner does not have a passport with him, but otherwise he has already joined the investigation and has fully cooperated with the investigation process and is not required for custodial investigation.

In view of the aforesaid specific stand taken by the learned State counsel, the present petition is allowed and the order dated 16.07.2021 is hereby made absolute.
