Matter has been taken up through video conferencing via Webex facility in the light of the Pandemic Covid-19 situation and as per instructions.

Petitionerd have preferred the instant petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C., for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.59 dated 23.05.2021, under Sections 354, 323, 341, 506 read with Section 34 of IPC registered at Police Station Bhadson, Tehsil Nabha, District Patiala.

By virtue of the order dated 16.07.2021, while granting interim protection, the petitioners were directed to join investigation. It has been contended by learned counsel for the petitioners that the petitioners have joined the investigation and fully cooperated and thus, the interim order may kindly be made absolute.
