The Court has been convened through video conferencing due to Covid-19 pandemic.

Instant petition has been filed under Article 227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a direction to official respondents No. 2 and 3 to take action on the representation dated 10.07.2021 (Annexure P-2) to protect the life and personal liberty of the petitioner and also to direct the private respondent not to interfere in her personal life.

Counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner was married to respondent No.4 in the year 2013 and a female child was born out of the wedlock in the year 2019. However, the husband of the petitioner has been constantly harassing the petitioner and demanding dowry. As a result of which, petitioner left her matrimonial home in the year 2019 and started staying with her sister. Counsel submits that thereafter, one Jasbir Singh gave her mental and economic support, which has been objected to by the

respondent No.4, who is threatening to eliminate her. Counsel submits that before approaching this Court, the petitioner has submitted a representation dated 10.07.2021 (Annexure P-2) to the Superintendent of Police, Ambala – respondent No.2, however, the same has not been attended to. He submits that the petitioner would be satisfied in case a direction is issued to the concerned respondent to look into the representation.

Request made by counsel for the petitioner has been considered.

Without expressing any opinion on the allegations made in the petition or in the representation, the petition is disposed of with a direction to the Superintendent of Police, Ambala – respondent No.2 to examine the representation dated 10.07.2021 (Annexure P-2) submitted by the petitioner and thereafter to take appropriate steps as warranted in accordance with law.

A copy of the representation dated 10.07.2021 (Annexure P-2) along with the petition be communicated to respondent No.2 so as to enable him to do the needful expeditiously.
