The prayer of the petitioners is for issuance of a direction to respondent No. 1 to ascertain as to whether, there is any threat to the life and liberty of the petitioners at the hands of respondent No. 3, who are the senior citizens and for taking appropriate action in case the same is required for in the facts and circumstances of the case.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the statement of learned counsel for the respondents satisfies the claim of the petitioners and he does not wish to press this writ petition any further and the same may be disposed of as such.
