Present writ petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for directing the respondents to consider the claim of the petitioner for regularization of his service as he had been appointed as daily wager w.e.f. 01.08.1984, the date since he is working as Beldar.

At the outset, learned Counsel for the petitioner has pointed out that instead of pressing the present petition on merits, his client would be satisfied in case the Legal Notice dated 12.04.2021 (P-8) is considered and decided by passing a speaking order expeditiously.

Prayer seems to be justified.

Notice of motion.

On the asking of the Court, Ms. Akshita Chauhan, AAG, Punjab, who is present through Video-Conference, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents and innocuous prayer of the petitioner is not opposed by her.

In view of the agreed stand taken by both sides, but without going into the merits of the controversy, this writ petition is disposed off with direction to respondent No.3-Executive Engineer, D.C. and Spillway Concreting Division, RSD, Shahpur Kandi, Tehsil & District Pathankot to consider and decide the aforesaid Legal Notice dated 12.04.2021 (P-8) in accordance with law by passing a speaking order preferably within a period of 04 (four) months from today.
