1. This is an application for placing on record the list of members of association as Annexure P-5, the resolution of association as Annexure P-6 and a quotation letter issued by the Maharashtra Company regarding supply of de-natured ethanol as Annexure P-7 and for exemption from filing the certified copy of the same.

2. For the reasons recorded in the application, the same is allowed as prayed for.

3. Annexures P-5 to P-7 are taken on record, subject to all just exceptions.

Main case

1. The petitioner has filed this writ petition alleging some anomaly between the requirement of the Excise Department and the Ayush Department.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner states that in this regard, the petitioner has moved representation (Annexure P-4) before respondent No.1 and prays that he will be satisfied at this stage if the direction is issued to respondent No.1 to decide the said representation in accordance with law.

3. Notice of motion.

4. On asking of this Court, Ms. Shruti Jain Goyal, DAG, Haryana appears and accepts notice on behalf of the respondents-State and fairly states that there may be some mismatch and it would be appropriate if respondent No.1 is directed to pass reasoned order.

5. In these circumstances, the writ petition is disposed of with direction to respondent No.1 to decide the representation (Annexure P-4) filed by the petitioner by passing speaking and reasoned order thereon within a period of two months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

6. Since the main case has been decided, the pending Civil Miscellaneous Application, if any, also stands disposed of.
