1. Case is being taken up for hearing through Video Conferencing due to Covid-19 pandemic.
2. Prayer in the petition under Sections 11 & 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971 read with Article 215 of the Constitution of India, is for initiating proceedings against the respondent for intentional and willful defiance of order (Annexure P-1) dated 08.04.2021, in CRM-M No.15572 of 2021.
3. Learned counsel contends that the instant petition was filed on account of failure of the respondent to take a decision on representation dated 15.03.2021 in terms of order dated 08.04.2021 in CRM-M No.15572 of 2021 but now the petitioner has been supplied copy of order dated 02.08.2021 passed by the Commissioner of Police, Ludhiana, deciding the petitioners representation holding there to be no threat to the life and liberty of the petitioner. Learned Counsel contends

that in the circumstances, the petitioner is not interested in pursuing the instant petition and the same may be disposed of as such, while granting liberty to the petitioner to challenge order dated 02.08.2021 passed by the Commissioner of Police, Ludhiana by way of appropriate proceedings in accordance with law.

4. In view of the position noted above, as well as statement of learned counsel for the petitioner, no action under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971 is required to be initiated against the respondent.

5. Accordingly, the contempt petition is *disposed of* as such, while granting liberty to the petitioner to challenge order dated 02.08.2021 by way of appropriate proceedings in accordance with law.
