The petitioners are seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No. 106 dated 24.05.2021, under Sections 307, 148, 149 and 427 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860, registered at Police Station City-1, Abohar, District Fazilka.

Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that it is alleged in the FIR that the petitioners are the members of a gang which had an inter-gang altercation. He, however, contends that the petitioners are in the early 20s and they are not involved in any other criminal case. He further contends that there is no MLR of any person, who is allegedly injured in the occurrence.

This Court, by the order dated 19.07.2021, had directed the petitioners to appear before the Investigating Officer and join the investigation and in the event of their arrest, they were ordered to be released on ad-interim bail to the satisfaction of the Investigating/Arresting Officer, subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Learned State counsel, upon instructions from ASI Sarwan Singh, states that the petitioners have joined investigation.

In view of the above, especially when the petitioners having joined investigation, the order dated 19.07.2021 granting interim bail to the petitioners is made absolute.

However, the petitioners shall abide by the conditions stipulated under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. They shall also join investigation as and when called upon to do so.

The petition stands disposed of.
