By this petition, originally the petitioner had challenged the action of cancellation of registration (Annexure P-3), but during the pendency of the writ petition, his application for revocation having been decided. The writ petition was amended to challenge that order as well.

2. It is not disputed that the said order is appealable.

3. In the circumstances, we dispose of this writ petition and allow the petitioner to now file an appeal against the order. If any appeal is now filed within a period of 15 days, that shall be decided on merits by the Appellant Authority, in accordance with law, within a period of one month thereafter.
