Learned counsel for the petitioner very fairly submits that the accused has already been arrested now and the investigation is being carried out but still, the direction be issued to the Investigating Agency to ensure free and fair investigation into the allegations alleged in FIR No.68 dated 21.03.2021.

Learned counsel for the respondents-State submits that nothing has come on record that the investigation being conducted in the present case is not fair or is biased in any manner, hence, no direction is needed to be given to the Investigating Agency as being prayed for. Learned counsel for the respondents-State further submits that the investigation will be carried out in accordance with law without causing prejudice either to the complainant or to the accused and the report of the investigation will be

submitted to the Registry in accordance with law within time framed prescribed.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that keeping in view the statement of the learned counsel for the respondents-State, no grievance of the petitioner survives in the present petition and the same may be disposed of having been not pressed any further.
