Case has been taken up for hearing through Video Conferencing.

This petition Section 482 Cr.P.C. has been moved by petitioners for issuance of direction to have a Magisterial Enquiry headed by either sitting Judicial Officer or a Retired Judicial Officer to inquire into the applications/complaints filed by the petitioners qua an incident wherein despite the incident being videographed, a false FIR has been registered against the residents of village where the police officials illegally went and tried to illegally kidnap a resident of the village.

Learned counsel for the petitioners contended that petitioners have already made representations to Director General of Police, Punjab, and Senior Superintendent of Police, District Tarn Taran, copy of which are available on the file as Annexures P/3 to P/6, but still no action has been taken.

Notice of motion.

At the asking of Court, Mr. Mehardeep Singh, Additional Advocate General, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of respondents. Complete copy of paper book has been supplied to him.

In view of above, the present petition is disposed of with the direction to respondent No.3 – Senior Superintendent of Police, District Tarn Taran (wrongly mentioned as Superintendent of Police, Amritsar Rural, Amritsar in the title of petition), to look into and decide representations (Annexures P/4 and P/6) in accordance with law by passing speaking order and that too within six weeks positively from the date of receipt of copy of this order.
