G.S. Sandhawalia, J. (Oral):-

Prayer in the present writ petition, filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India is for issuance of directions to the official respondents for fixing the seniority of High School Headmasters as on 01.06.2015, on the ground that their name does not find mention in the provisional seniority list issued by respondent No.2 (Annexure P-3).

Counsel for the petitioners contends that in pursuance of the said list, the official-respondents have called for the promotion cases to the post of Principal (Rest of Haryana Cadre) from the Headmasters and Post-Graduate Teachers (ROH Cadre).

It is the case of the petitioners that they have filed representations dated 08.07.2021 (Annexures P-4 & P-5) showing that the juniors have been shown in the said provisional seniority list but the petitioners' name does not find mention.

Notice of motion.

Mr.Kumar accepts notice on behalf of the respondents.

Keeping in view the fact that the representations have been filed only recently, this Court is not inclined to call upon the respondents to file reply as the decision making process is still incomplete and the same would only delay the proceedings.

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Accordingly, without commenting upon the merits of the case or the entitlement of the petitioners, the present writ petition is disposed of, with directions to respondent No.2 to take into consideration the said representations dated 08.07.2021 (Annexures P-4 & P-5) and take affirmative action, if so made out, within a period of 2 months. In case the petitioners are found entitled for the relief claimed, same be given effect to. In case the relief is to be declined, reasoned order be passed and communicated to the petitioners.
