The present petition has been filed under Section 482 read with Section 438 Cr.P.C. for the grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No.75 dated 03.02.2021 registered under Sections 323, 325, 34, 341, 506, 147, 148, 149 IPC and Sections 3/33/89 of the Scheduled Caste and Scheduled Tribe (Prevention of Atrocities) Act, 1989 at Police Station Sector 58, Faridabad District Faridabad.

For the relief claimed in the present petition the petitioner had earlier approached this Court through CRM-M-13040-2021 – Bobby Rawat vs State of Haryana which petition of his was dismissed on 22.03.2021 through the following order:-

“The arguments raised on behalf of the petitioner having not received a favourable response from the Bench and not to invite a decision on merits lest it may prejudice the case of the petitioner at a later stage, learned counsel for the

petitioner seeks to withdraw the present petition.

Permitted to do so.

Dismissed as withdrawn.”

A perusal of the afore quoted order reveals that the pleas raised on behalf of the petitioner having not received a favourable response from the Bench and only to prevent taking an order on merits lest it may prejudice the case of the petitioner at a later stage, learned counsel appearing for the petitioner had sought withdrawal of his petition and taking a lenient view in the matter he was permitted to do so.

After the dismissal of the petitioner's first petition for anticipatory bail through the afore quoted order no change in circumstance has been pointed out.

In view of the above as also for the reason that the petitioner is alleged to have inflicted the grievous injury on the complainant resulting in a fracture of his nasal bone, no ground is made out for grant of anticipatory bail.

Dismissed.
