1. Case is being taken up for hearing through Video Conferencing due to Covid-19 pandemic.

2. Prayer in the petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India is for the issuance of a writ in the nature of Mandamus for directing respondent Nos.1 to 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners and not to interfere in their married life at the hands of respondent Nos.4 to 6 and other relatives and friends.

3. Pursuant to the issuance of notice of motion, reply has been filed.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioners has referred to paragraph No.5 of the reply as per which, respondent No.4 i.e. the father of petitioner No.1 on 24.07.2021 made a statement to ASI Jagroop Singh of Police Station Mulepur that the date of birth of petitioner No.1 was 08.07.2003 and she was 9th pass and had become major on 08.07.2021

and had solemnized her marriage with petitioner No.2 (wrongly written as petitioner No.1) i.e. Gulshan Kumar son of Karamdeen, resident of Chanarthal Kalan of her own free will/wish and that he had no objection qua her marriage. In this regard, learned counsel has also referred Annexure R-1/T dated 18.07.2021 and Annexure R-8/T dated 24.07.2021 attached with the reply in which statement of father of petitioner No.1 is recorded.

5. Learned counsel for the petitioners states that in view of the position noted above, he does not press the instant petition and the same may be permitted to be withdrawn.

6. In the light of the position noted above and in view of the statement of learned counsel for the petitioners, the instant petition is dismissed as withdrawn and not calling for any further orders.
