The present petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C., for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.60 dated 26.05.2021 under Section 306 of the IPC registered at Police Station Kheri Nodh Singh, District Fatehgarh Sahib.

Learned counsel for the petitioner *inter alia* contends that it is a case of false implication, which is evident from the fact that the complainant has falsely implicated the entire in-laws family of his deceased daughter. He submits that the complainant's daughter i.e. deceased committed suicide while she was at her parental home subsequent to the delivery of her child. He further submits that similarly situated co-accused i.e. married daughter of the petitioner and her husband have since been extended the concession

of interim bail by this Court vide orders dated 15.06.2021 and 12.07.2021 respectively.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that pursuant to order dated 19th July 2021 passed by this Court, the petitioner has joined investigation.

Learned State counsel on instructions from SI Dharampal does not dispute the said fact and submits that the custodial interrogation of the petitioner is not required. He has apprised the Court that challan stands presented.

In the wake of the instructions received by the learned State counsel, the petition is allowed and interim order dated 19th July 2021 is made absolute subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438(2) CrPC.
