The hearing of the case was held through video conferencing on account of restricted functioning of the Courts.

As per the office report, notice issued to the respondent has been received back served, however, he remains unrepresented.

On 19.08.2021, the following order was passed:-

“The hearing of the case was held through video conferencing on account of restricted functioning of the Courts.

This petition has been filed by the wife seeking the transfer of the petition filed under Section 13 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955, bearing No.DMC/980/2019, titled as 'Deepak vs. Monika Gulia' pending in the Court of Additional Principal Judge, Family Court, Rohtak to the Court of competent jurisdiction at Jhajjar.

The petitioner claims that she got married to the respondent on 23.11.2017.

Learned counsel representing the petitioner contends that the respondent-husband is already facing trial in three cases in District Courts, Jhajjar i.e. FIR No.129, dated 13.08.2018, petition under Section 125 Cr.P.C and an application under Section 12 of the Protection of Women from Domestic Violence Act, 2005.

Notice of motion for 03.09.2021.

The liberty is granted to the petitioner to serve the respondent through his counsel Sh. Raj Kumar Dahiya, District Court, Jhajjar.

The facts noticed in the order dated 19.08.2021, remain uncontroverted.

Hence, the petition is allowed.

The petition under Section 13 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955, bearing No.DMC/980/2019, titled as 'Deepak vs. Monika Gulia' pending in the Court of Additional Principal Judge, Family Court, Rohtak, is ordered to be transferred to the Court of competent jurisdiction at Jhajjar.

The transferor Court is requested to remit the case file to the transferee Court forthwith.

The parties through their counsel are directed to appear before the transferee Court on 14.10.2021.

All the pending miscellaneous applications, if any, are also disposed of.
