The matter has been taken up through video conferencing on account of restrictions due to outbreak of COVID-19 pandemic.

Petitioner-Satinderjit Singh stated to be aged 46 years has filed the present writ petition *inter alia* with the prayer for directing the respondents to count the daily wage service of the petitioner rendered before regularization as qualifying service for the purpose of pensionary/retiral benefits alongwith further relief as mentioned in the petition.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner had made a request to the respondents, to count the daily wage service of the petitioner rendered before regularization as qualifying service for the purpose of pensionary/retiral benefits.

He further submits that for the same/similar grievance the petitioner has submitted a representation dated 28.04.2021 (Annexure P-6).
