This is a petition filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail in case FIR No. 89 dated 10.5.2021 registered under Sections 323, 341, 379 B, 148, 149 IPC at Police Station City Jagraon, District Ludhiana Rural.

FIR was registered on the complaint of one Baldev Singh who stated that on 9.5.2021 at about 11.45 pm, he alongwith his friend Sandeep Singh was present at milk diary. Petitioner knowing that complainant was veterinary doctor requested complainant to accompany him to examine the dog of his neighbour. The complainant accompanied the petitioner. When they reached near the house of petitioner, Hari Ram also came there. The petitioner allegedly raised a lalkara that complainant should not go alive today. He then forcibly snatched keys of motorcycle of complainant and started hitting him (complainant) and his friend Sandeep Singh with motorcycle keys on their faces. Meanwhile, Jasvir Kumar alias Kaka alongwith 3 unknown persons reached there. As the complainant was pushed, he fell down on ground. Thereafter, complainant was given fist and kick blows by Jasvir Kumar alias Kaka and 3 other unknown persons. Hari Ram hit complainant with base ball. Hari Ram also snatched mobile phone of complainant and his purse which contained Rs. 2200/-. He also snatched purse of Sandeep Singh containing Rs. 4500/-.

Learned counsel for petitioner has argued that allegations are totally false. Infact, it is a case of version and cross version. The petitioner has also lodged

a complaint against complainant Baldev Singh and Sandeep Singh. The injuries sustained by complainant are simple. The petitioner has clean antecedents. There is no criminal case registered against petitioner. The petitioner is in custody since 10.5.2021.

In view thereof and the fact that trial of case may take a long time due to prevailing situation on account of COVID 2019, no useful purpose would be served by keeping him behind bars. Hence, petition is allowed. Petitioner Jasraj alias Makhan is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing bail bonds and surety bonds to the satisfaction of trial Court/Duty Magistrate concerned.
