This is a petition filed under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure by the petitioner, seeking regular bail in case FIR No.209, dated 06.06.2020, under Sections 332, 353, 307, 427, 34 and 483 of the IPC, registered at Police Station Pundri, District Kaithal.

2. Seen Custody Certificate of the petitioner, from which it transpires that he has remained in detention for a period of eight months and seven days as on 17.02.2021. Investigation against him has already been completed and challan submitted. The petitioner is reported to be involved in another case, being FIR No.156 of 2020 of the same date, registered at Police Station Sadar Kaithal, Kaithal, in which he has already been granted bail.

3. In view of the above and without making any further comments on the merits of the case, this Court is of the opinion that further detention of

the petitioner for an indefinite period of time at this stage is not called for, therefore, his prayer for regular bail is allowed and he is ordered to be released on bail, subject to appropriate terms and conditions to the satisfaction of the Ld. Trial Court/Duty Magistrate concerned.
