Petitioners – Renu Bala and 6 others have jointly filed the present writ petition *inter alia* with a prayer to direct respondents to grant benefit of enhanced remuneration to the petitioners w.e.f. 01.04.2019 in compliance to order dated 15/16.09.2019 passed by respondent No.2 (Annexure P-5) as the said benefits has already been granted to the colleagues of the petitioners, with a further relief as mentioned in the petition.

Records of the case show that on 06.10.2020 the matter was adjourned on the request of State counsel to seek instructions.

Today on resumed hearing of the case, learned counsel for respondent No.2 submits that the necessary relief has already been granted to the petitioners vide orders dated 16.12.2020 and 01.01.2021.

In this view of the matter, no further orders are called for.

Accordingly, the present writ petition is disposed of as having become infructuous.

If, however, any grievance still remains as per the petitioners, the petitioners are at liberty to move consolidated representation within a period of *two months* from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order and the same be decided by the respondents/Competent Authority within *three months* from the date of receipt of representation, if any.
