The Court has been convened through video conferencing due to Covid-19 pandemic.

Instant petition has been filed under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for issuance of a direction to official respondents No. 2 and 3 to look into the grievance of petitioner and to initiate action on the representation dated 12.04.2021 (Annexure P-4) against the private respondents.

Counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner is a song writer and the White Hill Music Company – respondent No.9 has played fraud with him. Counsel submits that before approaching this Court, the petitioner has submitted a representation dated 12.04.2021 (Annexure P-4) to the Senior Superintendent of Police, Fazilka – respondent No.5, however, the same has not been attended to. Counsel submits that the petitioner would be satisfied in case a direction is issued to the concerned respondent to look into the representation.

Request made by counsel for the petitioner has been considered.

Without expressing any opinion on the allegations made in the petition or in the representation, the petition is disposed of with a direction to the Senior Superintendent of Police, Fazilka – respondent No.5 to examine the representation dated 12.04.2021 (Annexure P-4) submitted by the petitioner and thereafter to take appropriate steps as warranted in accordance with law.

A copy of the representation dated 12.04.2021 (Annexure P-4) along with the petition be communicated to respondent No.5 so as to enable him to do the needful expeditiously.
