The petitioners have filed this petition being aggrieved by running of poultry farm by respondent No.5 in village Kothe Sangat Kalan, District Bathinda. The petitioners submit that they have already filed complaints against causing of pollution and violation of environmental loss being made by respondent No.5 before Deputy Commissioner, Bathinda as well as Senior Environmental Engineer, Punjab Pollution Control Board Zonal Office, Bathinda but the said officers have not taken any action.

Learned Senior Deputy Advocate General appearing for the respondent-State of Punjab submits that respondent No.3 shall look into the complaints of the petitioner and shall also convey the directions of this Court to decide the complaints filed by the petitioners to the Senior Environmental Engineer, Punjab Pollution Control Board, Zonal Office, Bhatinda.

In view of the aforesaid statement made by learned Senior Deputy Advocate General, Punjab, the petition filed by the petitioners is disposed of permitting the petitioners to pursue their complaints/representations before the said authority. It goes without saying that in view of the statement made by learned Senior Deputy Advocate General, Punjab, the said authority shall look into the petitioners' complaints/representations and take a decision thereon expeditiously in accordance with law.
