The Court has been convened through video conferencing due to Covid-19 Pandemic.

Instant petition has been filed under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.148 dated 12.06.2021, registered for offence under Section 21 (b) of Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985 (for short “the NDPS Act”) at Police Station City Narwana, District Jind (Annexure P-1).

Having argued the petition for some time and realizing that the Court is not inclined to agree with the submissions made, counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner will surrender before the trial Court and file a petition for grant of regular bail.
