Due to outbreak of pandemic COVID-19, the instant case is being taken up for hearing through video conferencing.

The petitioner has invoked the jurisdiction of this Court in terms of Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking prayer by way of writ of *mandamus* for issuance of directions to the respondents authorities for grant of family pension to the petitioner w.e.f. 04.05.2015 from the date of missing of the petitioner's husband as per Government of India letter dated 13.07.2010 (Annexure P-7), 24.02.2012 (Annexure P-8), 15.07.2013 (Annexure P-9) and 24.06.2013 (Annexure P-10) along with the interest @ 18% per annum till the payment is made.

Heard.

Upon hearing learned counsel of both the sides and on perusal of the records, the present petition stands disposed off with the directions to the official respondents to consider the legal notices dated 30.06.2018 & 07.02.2019 (Annexures P-5 and P-6, respectively) as representation moved by the petitioner and decide the same in accordance with law, by passing a speaking order preferably within a period of one month from the date of receipt of the certified copy of this order.

If found entitled and if there is no impediment for the release of payment, the same be granted to the petitioner without any delay, as per law.

The petition stands disposed off accordingly.
