The instant petition has been filed under Section 438 of Cr.P.C., for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners in the event of arrest in case FIR No.63 dated 02.06.2020 under Sections 323, 324, 427, 148, 149, 188 IPC (later on added Sections 452, 326, 307 & 120-B IPC) registered at Police Station Sadar Banga, District SBS Nagar.

Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that the petitioners have been falsely implicated in the present case and on the direction of this Court, have joined the investigation. It is also contended that nothing is to be recovered from them.

Learned A.A.G., Punjab, on instructions from ASI Inderjeet Singh, submits that petitioners have joined the investigation and they are not required for the custodial interrogation.

In view of the facts that the petitioners are not required for custodial interrogation and have joined the investigation, without commenting on the merits of the case, the petition is allowed and order dated 17.10.2020 granting interim bail to the petitioners is made absolute subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438 Sub Section 2 Clauses (i)(ii) and (iii) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
